ALL SCHOOLS RESULTS

The NSW All Schools Championships was held last week at the Sydney Olympic Park. All the BlueScope Steel scholarship holders competed well, with a number of them medalling. Talissa Scott (Pictured right) made four finals, winning the 16 years long jump, finishing 2nd in the 16 years 100m hurdles, 3rd in the 200m sprint and then 4th in the 100m, despite running the exact same time as the 3rd placegetter.



Joshua Kentwell (Pictured below) won the 13 years 1500m race with Hamish Paine 9th in the same event. Abbie Taddeo made the final of the girls 15 years 100m and 200m sprint as well as the 90m hurdles. After finishing 6th in both 100 and 200, Taddeo picked up a silver medal in the 90m hurdles. Karlie Chambers picked up silver in the 15 years 400m sprint.



Graduate, Sara Carli, has been mixing distance running with hurdles with some success. Carli ran 2nd in the 15 years 1500m event then ran 3rd in the 200m hurdles.
