The NSW short course age champs concluded last Sunday at the SOPAC venue. The IAS Sydney Water squad competed and took home a swag of medals.

McKeon set two state records & one country record in individual events and was part of two relay teams that set new state records. Her wins were in the 50, 100 and 200m freestyle, the 100 and 200m backstroke events as well as the 4 x 100m freestyle and medley relay races.

Also doing exceptionally well was Zoe Elkerton, with 8 medals all up. Elkerton had 2 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze medals in individual events to go with the 2 relay golds.

The third member of the relay team was Alexis Mastro, who finished with the 2 gold and four other top ten finishes. For the boys, Jarrod Poort won gold in the 200m freestyle, whilst Jordan Chyra had two top ten results.

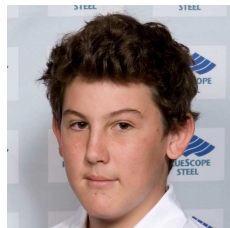

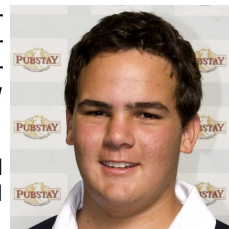
