The South Pacific junior tournament was played last week at the Warilla Bowls club, with some fine performances for the Academy bowlers.



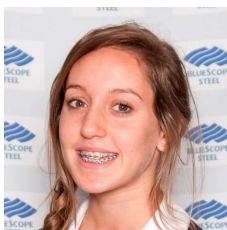

Golf **NEAR MISS**

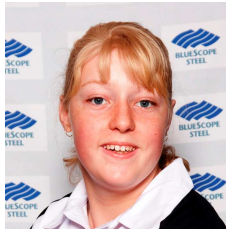
Graduate, Jordan Zunic has put in one of his best performances ever at the Australian amateur match play championships, that was held at the Woodlands golf club in Melbourne.
